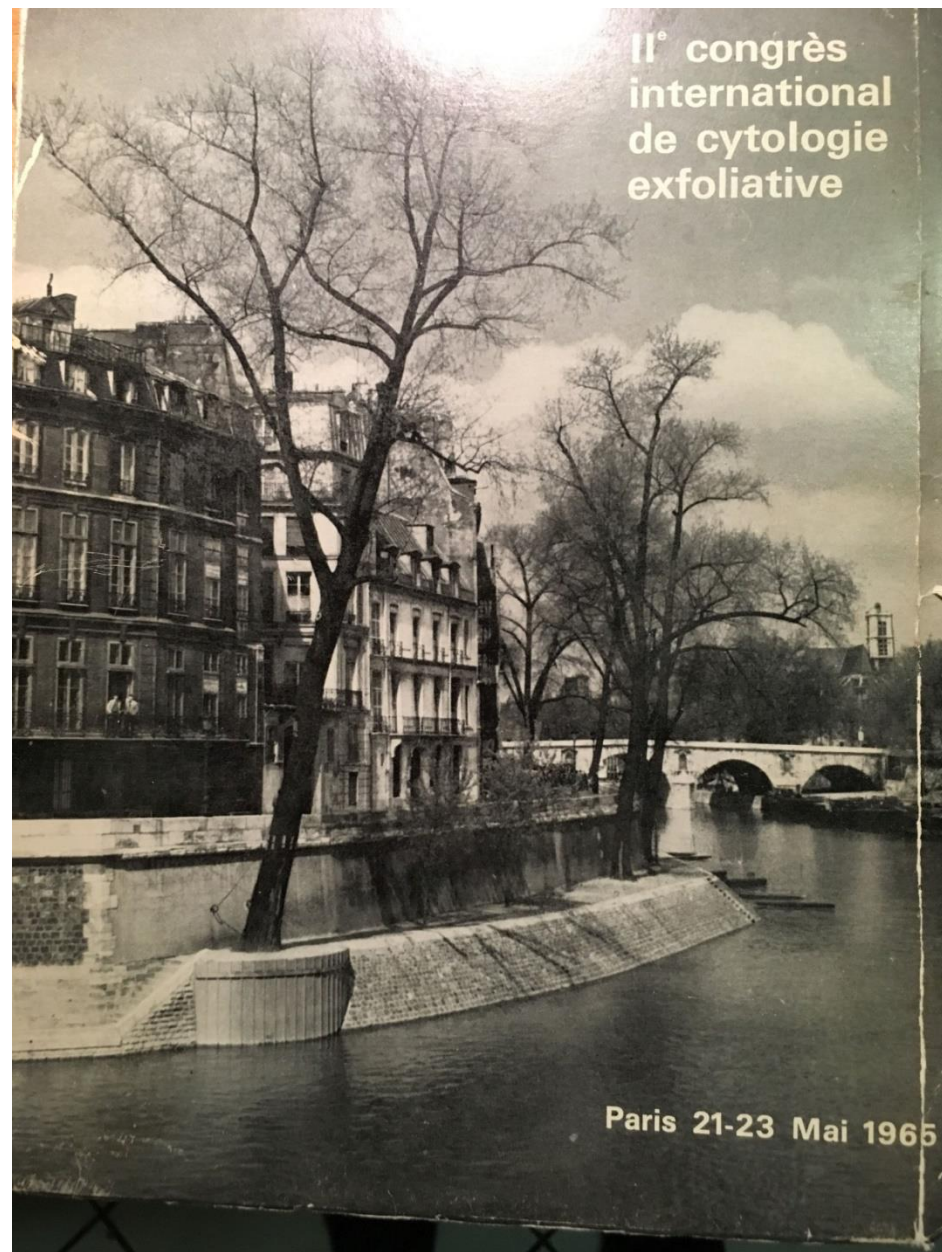

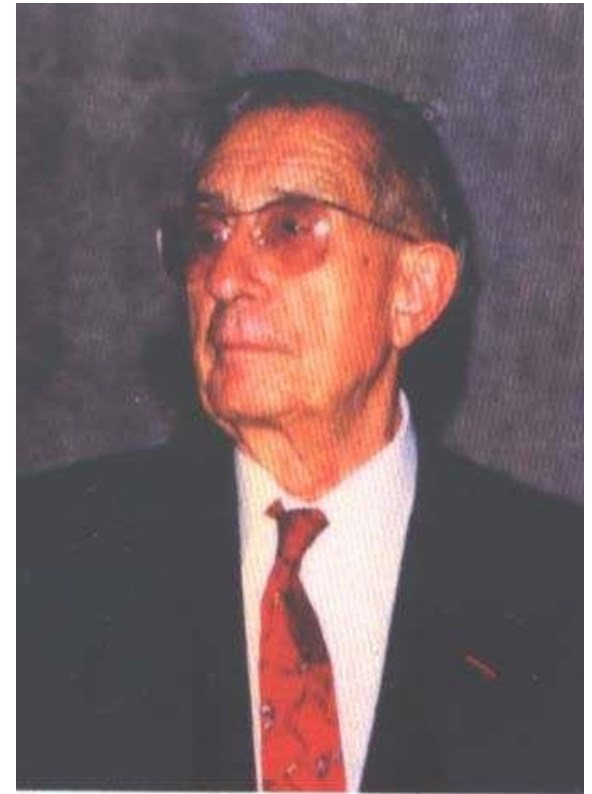

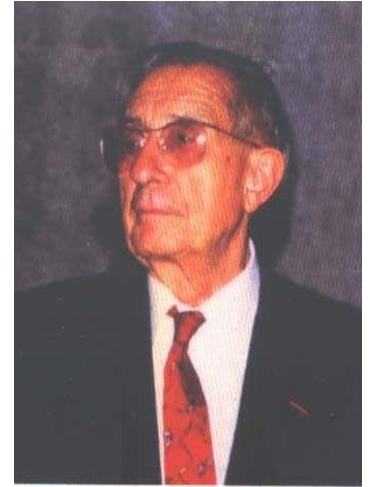

specialized in Gyn Pathology and Cytology;**

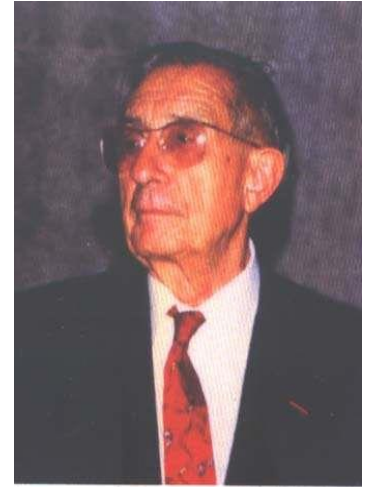
**Was a founding member of the International Academy of

**How to determine age
scientifically ?**

Dendrochronology !

Dendrochronology is the dating and study of annual rings in trees:

- ***dendros***: from trees, or more specifically the growth rings of trees
- ***chronos***: time, or more specifically events in past time

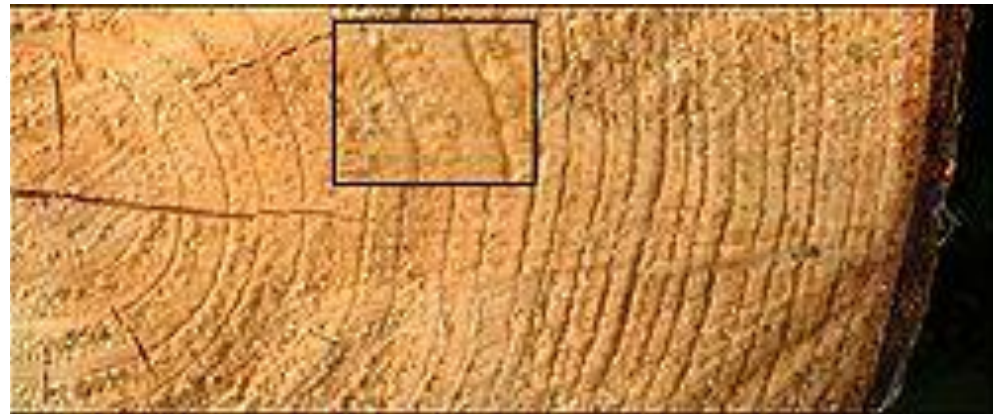
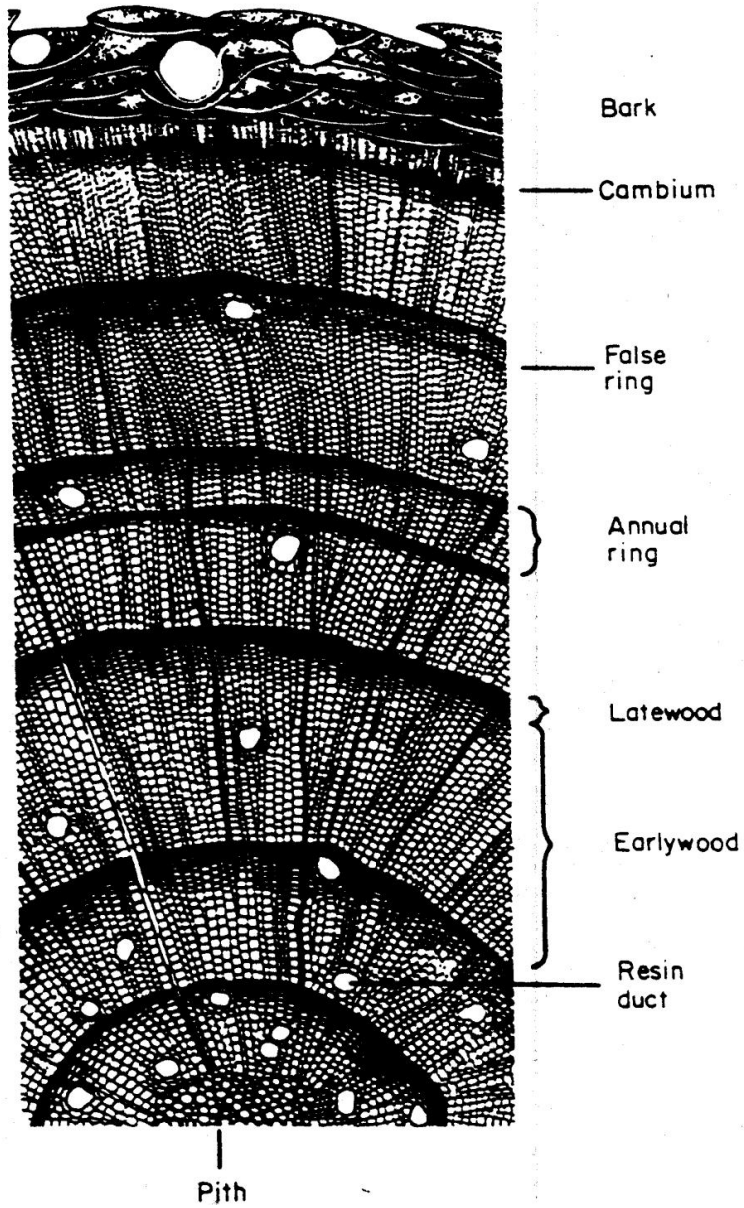

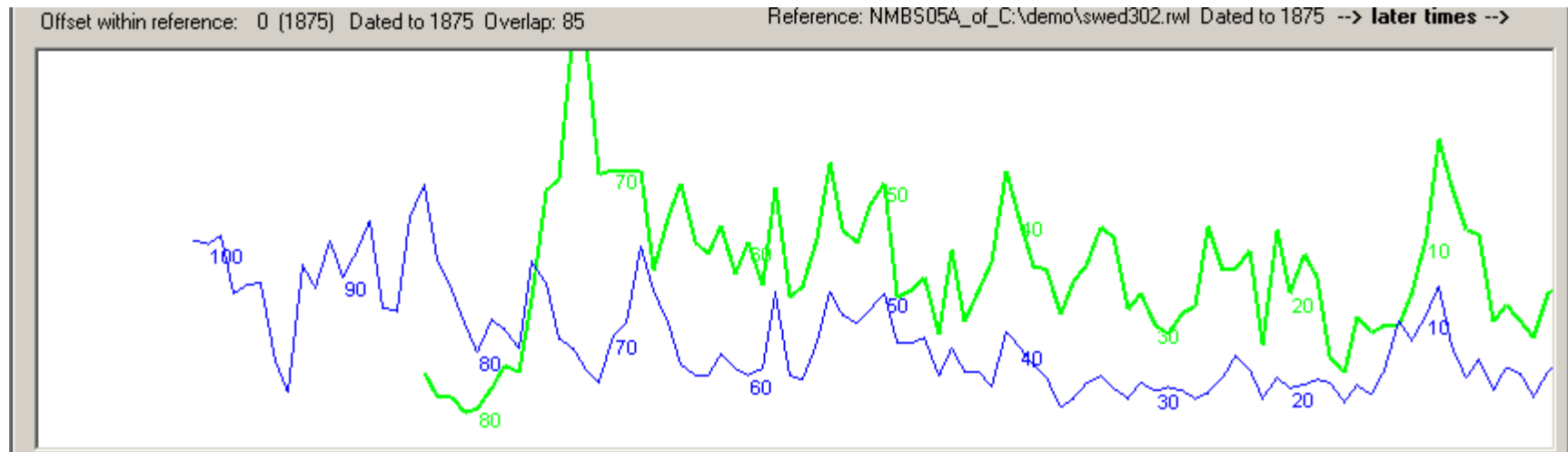

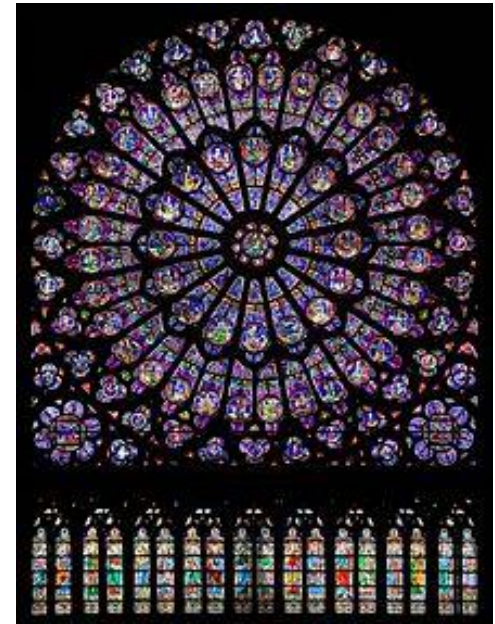

Our Lady of Paris: Notre Dame

The rose could belong to the 1230s. The dendrochronology of the roof has generated dates that are a bit later than anticipated.

Much of the wood for the choir roof was felled just before 1177.

The nave roof embodied timber from around 1220, but has tie beams felled as late as 1275m indicating significant work of repair.

Key findings: Dendrochronology revealed that the painting dated from the sixteenth century rather than the eighteenth century, as was previously thought.



Justification for dating

The date for the last tree ring was found to be 1552 which provides a conjectural usage-date of 1560-1592.

On the other hand, dendrochronology was applied to four paintings depicting the same subject, that of [Christ expelling the money-lenders from the Temple](#). The results showed that the age of the wood was too late for any of them to have been painted by [Hieronymus Bosch](#).^[37]

What is my own interest in dendrochronology ?

House of my great grandfather



We took 16 dendro probes:

**Ten of those revealed dates of 1558 to 1562,
So, the house is 450 years old.**

**Six probes revealed dates of 1745 to 1750,
So, 200 years later, the house was renovated.**
